



Turing House School has been awarded the 'Good Diabetes Care in School Award' which is a fantastic achievement! The award recognises schools who make sure




children and teenagers with Type 1 Diabetes get the care and support they need so they can reach their potential.

To introduce items in a list. E.g. I have three wishes: more time, more money, more sleep.


To introduce a quotation. E.g. The writer used her favourite quote: 'all's well that ends well'.
