RE: Transition Pack, Headteachers' Challenge, Medical Diagnoses and Medication

I do hope that this correspondence finds you all safe and well.

We loved meeting you and your children at our Meet the Teachers evening. Following this, we are now busy preparing to welcome our new Year 6 students for their first transition day on Monday 7th July. Much work is currently going on 'behind the scenes', as Turing House works together with all local primary schools to prepare to support students both academically and pastorally.

We have attached our Transition Guide, which is aimed at your child and should help with answering your questions and preparing for the point at which we can officially welcome your child to our community in person. Alongside this, I have included my challenge to your children for the summer. Although students have been asked to complete as many as possible, it is not a competition – we hope that all will try a few of the activities and that they may give you some things to keep them occupied over the summer break! The Maths department have also created a welcome pack for you to enjoy.

Finally, as part of our transition process, we want to ensure we have all the correct documentation related to your child. To that end, if your child has a formal diagnosis of any medical condition, please could you send us a copy of the consultant's diagnosis letter. We work very hard with our primary schools and are diligent in collecting information and documents from them, but we are coming direct to you with this request to avoid anything being missed. Furthermore, if your child takes regular medication prescribed for a specific condition, could you please advise us of what that medication is and the specific dosage. If you require support such as holding any medication at school, then let us know.

Please send all information and letters to: info@turinghouseschool.org.uk with the name of your child and 'diagnosis' or 'medication' in the subject line and we will save the information to our secure system. If you prefer, you can bring in a physical copy to school and a member of the office team will scan it.

We are very much looking forward to September; I am sure I will be in touch with you again between now and then, but I would like to take this opportunity to wish you and your family good health.
